

Electronic Monitoring (Brooklyn)

This program requires the defendant to wear a transmitter on their ankle and house a unit in their home, which is attached to the telephone. In addition, the telephone line can not have any special features.

There are two levels of monitoring:

A) home detention- the defendant is required to remain at home unless the Court permits him/her to leave for employment, education, medical, substance abuse, mental health treatment, religious activities, or other specified reasons such as to purchase food.

B) home incarceration- the defendant is required to remain at home at all times except for medical emergencies or other activities approved by the Court.

Defendants who have the electronic monitoring condition and are supervised from the Brooklyn Office, should call 718-260-4573 and leave a message in the appropriate officer's mailbox. All faxes are to be sent to 718-613-2488.

For defendants who violate their pretrial release conditions, the court may impose the electronic monitoring program or curfew with voice verification as an additional condition of release, in lieu of detention.
